### **Year 11 Final examinations and leavers dates**

I am writing to you regarding our Year 11 students completing their final exams and leaving Filey School.

The final whole year group examination is Physics on Friday 16th June. On this day there is also a Geography exam. The following week there are exams in Design Technology, Food preparation and nutrition and Polish for some students.

We therefore plan to have a leavers assembly and celebration late in the afternoon on Friday 16th June for students who are eligible to attend. This will involve a short assembly, some refreshments, and the chance to sign shirts, speak to teachers and sign leavers books. If students wish to sign shirts, they should bring with them a spare shirt that they can have signed. It is important to note that students **MUST NOT** write on shirts prior to entering their exams as this could breach the examination board rules and result in disqualification from exams. We ask students to bring their spare shirts for signing to prevent this.

Following the leavers assembly on 16th June, we will expect only to see those students who have their final three exams in school. They will attend purely during their exams.

This then leaves us with a few important date reminders. The year 11 prom, for those students who remain eligible to attend, will take place on Friday 30th June and importantly the GCSE exam results day on Thursday 24th August.

We also ask that if anyone can donate uniform that is no longer needed to the school they do so via reception before the Summer holidays. Your kind donations mean that we are able to support families in our local community who may need a little extra help.

Please may I remind all parents, carers and students that crucial masterclasses continue to take place this week and should be attended by all students medically fit to be in school. These masterclasses provide information that is crucial for their exam success and enables them to have the same information that other students sitting the exam will be advantaged with. In line with the Department for Education Guidance we do not grant study leave except in exceptional circumstances.
